To schedule your tour the best time to call is in the evening as we are usually on the river during the day. You can also go to our calendar on our web site view what days we have open and then email us for questions or too schedule your desired date.

Skagit Eagle Tours:

Bald Eagles migrate to the Skagit, from Alaska and Canada, beginning in November to feed off the salmon that have returned to the river to spawn. Typically the best viewing times are December and into January. Depending on the salmon run we may also have eagles into February.

From Seattle take Interstate 5 north to exit 232 (Cook Road), from here it will take you approximately 45 minutes. Take right at the top of the ramp and follow Cook Road to Hwy 20 (about 4 miles). At Hwy 20 take a left and follow to Rockport mile marker 97(about 30 miles). At Rockport store take a right at Hwy 530 interchange, and then the next right into Howard Miller Steelhead Park.

Our rally point is at the traffic cone with a red flag at the corner of Hwy 530 and Rockport Park Road. (the entrance to Howard Miller Steelhead Park) It will also help to know that you will be looking for a burgundy truck or a red Suburban with a large silver drift boat and Skagiteagles.com on the side. Someone will be in the area to check you in and direct you to your guide. Please get to the park 15 minutes early as we will be leaving the park at the scheduled departure time. We want your tour to be enjoyable and if you are late it will mean the others on the tour must stand around waiting. (Believe me you don't want to get the "you're late" look from the rest of our clients).

Skagit Fishing Trips:

The best fishing times are September through December for fall salmon. We also fish The Olympic Peninsula rivers for Steelhead January through March. Call us to schedule your trip.
